Inside this guide, you'll discover exciting ways to spend time with God every day through fun activities and conversations. God loves all of us so much that He wants to hang out with us regularly, and we're here to help you deepen your friendship with Him during the next 14 days...

As you journey through this journal, you'll get to know God better and learn some cool skills to continue your daily adventures with Him through His Word.

This year, we're focusing on the theme "Dwelling Place," inspired by Psalm 91:1. It reminds us that when we're close to God, we find peace and protection like snuggling up in our Favourite chill spot. Let's snuggle up with God and become even closer as friends!

GETTING STARTED

- 1. Choose to spend some time with God each day.
 - 2. Find a place around your home where you can write or draw in your journal.
 - 3. Have a pen, pencil(s), crayon(s) with you as you get ready to journal.
- 4. Turn to today's page in your journal and use your Bible to read the Daily Bible Verse. Take some time to think about the scripture (Bible verse/passage) you read and ask the Holy Spirit to help you understand it.
- 5. Write or draw anything that comes into your mind when your thinking about God and the scripture you read using the blank spaces provided for the day. You could also do the S.O.A.P way of journalling found on the next page.
- 6. Remember to read and do the Daily Adventure to learn new ways to spend time with God.

How to S.O.A.P

Follow these steps to help you understand and apply the Bible to your life.

Start by praying "Jesus please help me to understand the Bible and to help me hear what you want me to say. .Amen"

5- Scripture

Copy a verse that stands out

0- Observation

What is God showing you in this passage?
What is happening in the verse?
What does it mean?

A- Application

How does God want me to apply this verse to my life?

P- Prayer

Write out a prayer asking God to help me to apply it to my life

Colossians 3:1-4 (NIV)

You are not your mistakes, you are not your past, and your worst day with


God will be better than your best day without Him.



Use this time to talk about what it means to seek God and how you can dwell in His presence always.


DEVOTIONAL:

Day 9 tuesday 10th September Revelation 4 - the throne in Heaven


4 I looked, and there before me was a door standing open in heaven. And the voice I had first heard speaking to me like a trumpet said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this." 2 At once I was in the Spirit, and there before me was a throne in heaven with someone sitting on it. 3 And the one who sat there had the appearance of jasper and ruby. A rainbow that shone like an emerald encircled the throne. 4 Surrounding the throne were twenty-four other thrones, and seated on them were twenty-four elders. They were dressed in white and had crowns of gold on their heads. 5 From the throne came flashes of lightning, rumblings and peals of thunder. In front of the throne, seven lamps were blazing. 6 Also in front of the throne there was what looked like a sea of glass, clear as crystal.

In the center, around the throne, were four living creatures, and they were covered with eyes, in front and in back. 7 The first living creature was like a lion, the second was like an ox, the third had a face like a man, the fourth was like a flying eagle. 8 Each of the four living creatures had six wings and was covered with eyes all around, even under its

wings. Day and night they never stop saying:

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty,'[b] who was, and is, and is to come."

9 Whenever the living creatures give glory, honor and thanks to him who sits on the throne and who lives for ever and ever, 10 the twenty-four elders fall down before him who sits on the throne and worship him who lives for ever and ever. They lay their crowns before the throne and say:



1] "You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being."

Favourite Verse-


Pick out your favourite verses from this scripture and create a way that you can memorise them. You might choose to leave out words when writing it down or practice them while you tie your shoelaces.


Day 12 Friday 13th September HOPE
